

How to get to The CREATE Centre

Resource Futures is based at The CREATE Centre on Smeaton Road in the Cumberland Basin area of Bristol.

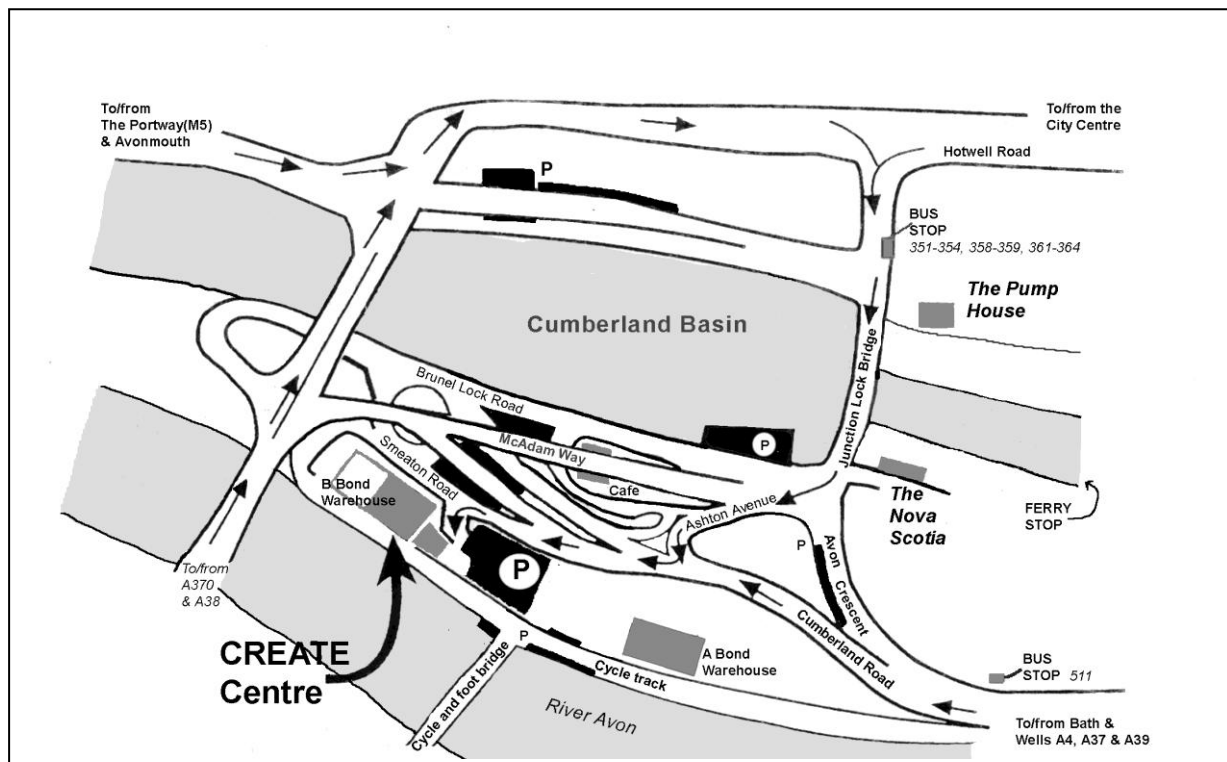
By Train: Temple Meads mainline railway station, serviced by trains from across the country, is situated around 2 miles from CREATE and is reached by either taxi, the 506 bus service or by ferry (see below).

By Ferry: The Bristol Ferry Boat Company operates from April to September with pick-up points around the city centre and Temple Meads railway station. The ferry stops next to the Nova Scotia public house just a few yards from CREATE. Ferries run half hourly from about 10am to 6.00pm. By Bus: The 506 service runs from Broadmead shopping centre (stop Sb) and Temple Meads railway station (stop Ta) at 30 minute intervals between 7am and 7pm.

By Bike: From the city centre a purpose-built cycle track runs from the east, alongside Cumberland Road and past A Bond warehouse.

By Road: See map below



Car Parking:

There is limited free parking (P) at or near The CREATE Centre and so the use of car sharing/public transport is actively encouraged.
